

Parents' risk perception of drowning among young children

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Aim of this study:

To gain insight into parents' risk perception of drowing in and around the house among children aged 0-4 years.



What we did...

414 parents with a child 0-4 years of age



Online questionnaire




Topics:

- Knowledge
- Supervisory behavior
- Social norms



Results – parental knowledge

"When my child is nearly drowning, my child will start to ..."






Results – parental knowledge



"It is possible that my child may drown in water with a depth of..."



- Only a small layer of water (10 cm)
- When my child is sitting upright and the water is up to the chin
- My child is not able to stand up in the water
- I don't know
- Another answer

Results – supervisory behavior

If we are with several parents/adults, we make clear agreements about who will continuously supervise the children


When my child is near water, I stay close enough to my child that I can touch my child

I make sure I can see my child all the time, when there is water around

Always

Everywhere I go, I know or check if my child can come near water




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
Results – supervisory behavior

I let older children look after my child when my child is in/near water

When the doorbell or phone rings, I leave my child playing in/near water alone for a while

Don't know





Parents show incorrect beliefs about nearly drowning

They underestimate the risk of drowning and the importance of supervision

Call for education to increase risk awareness among parents



Social media campaign



Translation: Head under goes silently and quikly

Prevent drowning with 4 safety rules in and around water

Banner inflatable bath: Banner opblaasbadje

Kopje onder gaat geluidloos en snel.

Voorkom verdrinking met de 4 van veilig in en om water.

Poster "4 rules for safe and fun water play"

... I make sure I can always see my child

Als ik in de buurt van water ben, dan...

laat ik mij nergens door afleiden

... I stay as close to my child to touch him



zorg ik dat ik mijn
